— From Sydney to San Diego —

Australian Emma Weinert started riding lessons as a child in her home city of Sydney, where she discovered her lifelong love for horses.

As a teenager, Emma's family bought her a warmblood horse, a big four year old gelding named Darius.

An avid learner, Emma immersed herself in the sport and together, she and Darius climbed the ranks in the local dressage scene all the way to the FEI levels.

After orchestrating a clinic with her idol Steffen Peters in Australia in 2008, Emma was so impressed with his training that she packed her bags and moved to California (along with Darius), to start training full time at the Peters' San Diego property.

With Steffen's assistance, Emma purchased an inexperienced broodmare (to ride!) and a young stallion from Europe.

Several years later, Emma is still based with Steffen and Shannon Peters and has made her mark on the dressage scene in the US.

Her 'broodmare' Velvet is now a CDI*** winner, and her stallion Zidane is now gelded and a successful small tour horse. Most recently, Emma rode Velvet to a win in the Grand Prix Special at the Festival of the Horse CDI3* in California.

Emma is in demand for clinics in the US, where she is known for her kind, soft and effective training method. Her approach is strongly focused on the correct use of the rider's body in the saddle, which she says is the key to getting great results.
